Biblical Counseling

Foundations & Distinctives

- **1. Biblical Counseling Rests on the Sufficiency of the Word of God** (Psalm 1:1-3; Psalm 19; Psalm 119; 2 Timothy 3:15-17*; Hebrews 4:12; 2 Peter 1:3-4).
- **2. Biblical Counseling Exists in Every Church Ministry** (Acts 20:31; Colossians 1:28; 1 Thessalonians 5:14).
- **3. Biblical Counseling Is Something Every Christian Can Do at Some Level** (Romans 15:14; Colossians 3:16-17; Hebrews 3:12-15; 1 Thessalonians 5:14)

This means that counseling matters are <u>not</u> reserved for the professionals.

- 4. Biblical Counseling Cannot Be Separated from Biblical Discipleship (Matthew 28:18-20)
- **5.** Biblical Counseling Gets at the Real, Fundamental Issues Sourced in the Heart (Hebrews 4:12; Mark 7:20-22*; Matthew 12:34; Romans 12:1-2).
- 6. Biblical Counseling Presupposes that the Gospel of Jesus Christ Is the Glorious Antidote to Sin.
- 7. Biblical Counseling Has a Specific Goal Biblical Heart Change which Transforms Thinking & then Behavior; Thus, Conformity to Jesus Christ (Romans 8:28-29; 1 John 2:6; Ephesians 5:1-2).

Presuppositions:

If a person is regenerated (saved)

If that person has the power of the Holy Spirit

If the Word of God is powerfully, directly, & specifically brought to bear

If the power of prayer is daily relied upon

If the counselee will work hard & putting off old sins & putting on new habits *THEN* biblical *heart* change resulting in a transformed life can occur!

Summary of Biblical Counseling Presuppositions...

- 1. Biblical Counseling is for believers only.
- 2. Biblical Counseling examines, applies & utilizes the sufficiency of Scripture.
- 3. Biblical Counseling relies upon the power of prayer.
- 4. Biblical Counseling demands time, effort, diligence, & commitment.

NOTE:

- 1. Biblical counseling is concerned fundamentally with the heart (*not* behavior alone).
- 2. Biblical counseling desires to see life change occur to the glory of God & the joy of the saint.
